Several hundred people who had never seen nature up close are now more familiar with their **natural world** in the greater San Jose area. One lasting effect is that they are able to use the **iNaturalist tool** anywhere they go. *"Everyone got excited by small overlooked creatures!" - BioBlitz Participant*

Restoration

We removed invasive plants, planted native shrubs, and provided trail maintenance including at the **Coyote Creek Field Station**. Attendees felt a sense of accomplishment as they looked back at their efforts that will make a difference in the health of the Bay.

Culture, Education, and Recreation

Working with the City of San Jose, the Open Space Authority, and others, we provided cultural context to Coyote Creek through **Kelley Park Sunset Walks**. Additionally, our 8 recreational **bike rides** and a **kayak outing** allowed people to experience the creek socially.

Creek Cleanups

If not for the 821 people who came out creek cleanups, over **25 tons of trash** would have ended up in **San Francisco Bay**, where fish and other aquatic species would ingest large and micro pieces of garbage. *"Getting to help clear up trash and spend time with my friends."* - Cleanup Participant
